

Questions:

- ◆ Have you ever, as a student, written on a topic of interest and importance to you in a voice that was comfortable and natural for you? When? What were those writing experiences like? What do you think you learned from those experiences of writing? What sorts of readers would have found those pieces of writing appealing?
- ◆How can voice be used by the powerful?
